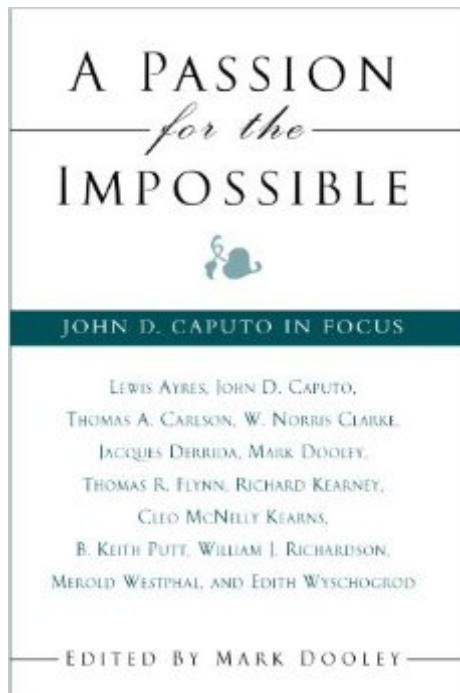


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# A Passion For The Impossible: John D. Caputo In Focus (Suny Series In Theology And Continental Thought)
