Article	<ul style="list-style-type: none">Description of the article.Date received or examined, original owner's name, address,Anything known about its origin and chain of ownership.
Book	<ul style="list-style-type: none">Author, Title (Publication place: publisher, date), page.Tip: Check back of title page to see if this is a reprint of an older book; if so, also record the original publication year. In print, the volume is paper (see form).
Book chapter	<ul style="list-style-type: none">Individual Author, "Chapter Title,"Editor, Book Title (Publication place: publisher, date), page numbers for start-stop points and specific date.
Column	<ul style="list-style-type: none">Creator of column, type, and date.Date, country name, road, characteristic detail, page, shelving family number, person by exact spelling.Then add:
Certificate	<ul style="list-style-type: none">Identification of media according to one of the media types below.Name of agency that issued certificate (e.g., newspaper, newspaper, newspaper).Certificate number, name of key person, date of issue.
Discussion, Letter, or Manuscript (unwritten text)	<ul style="list-style-type: none">Author, "Name of Document or Manuscript," date (place written).For online collection name and number.Author name, city, state/province, country.
Manuscript register (unwritten, city hall, church)	<ul style="list-style-type: none">Details from the upper or lower, then page number and specific date.Office or church name, city/province, state/province, country.

Microform	<ul style="list-style-type: none">Full details for the material that has been imaged—using one of the source types above.Library's label for the film or tape—taken from "film page" at start of film or tape.Agency that created the film, and filing date—usually found at start of film.

• DIRECT ACCESS	<ul style="list-style-type: none">Same pattern as for citing a book—i.e.,Creator, Title (Publication place/LBI), date, internal location of specific item.
• OFFICE OR DATABASE	<ul style="list-style-type: none">Same pattern as for citing a chapter in a book—i.e.,Author, "Article or Database Title," Website creator, Site Title (URL), date, specific item.
• DOCUMENT PAGE	<ul style="list-style-type: none">Details for the material that has been digitized—using one of the source types above.Then add:Site creator, Site Title (Publication place/LBI), date, specific item.

In this two-sided laminated QuickSheet, Elizabeth Mills offers the bare-naked essentials of citing sources for everything from books and articles to manuscripts and websites. Showing how easy (and necessary) it is to cite your sources accurately, she provides a template that can be applied by anyone using almost any type of source material. In a single chart containing ten main entries, she actually creates a comprehensive--if bare-boned--guide to citing sources. On top of that she offers a unique form to fill out--a source-data collection form for use at point of contact with each source. Starting with a column containing the basic elements from author/creator to manuscript and microfilm, the form provides space for notes for each specific source, so that each source consulted can be unmistakably identified, answering the basic who, what, where, and when type of questions as quickly and easily as possible. For a quick overview of the methods of citing sources, this QuickSheet is indispensable and easily lives up to its famous name.
